We have 3 "excessive AMP expenditure" TP cases from India (Sony, LG, and PepsiCo) - when will this line of cases ever end? We have an Indian Supreme Court TP case on corporate guarantee fees (Glenmark Pharmaceuticals). And we also have the BHP Billiton "sufficiently influenced" case from Australia : can A be "sufficiently influenced" by B, and B be "sufficiently influenced" by A, at the same time? Yes – just ask any married couple!
